## Texas Governor's Mansion Punch Recipe

- 3 Family Sized Tea Bags
- 4 Cups packed fresh mint leaves
- 4 Cups water
- 2 Bottles Knudsen's Peach Nectar

- 1 12 oz can lemonade concentrate
- 2 (1 liter bottles ginger ale chilled)
- 2 (1 liter bottles club soda chilled)
- 1/2 1 cup simple syrup

Boil water to steep tea & mint about 15 minutes. Remove tea. Leave mint until cool. Strain into 2 gallon container. Combine lemonade, pectar, and syrup (taste before adding syrup). To finish add 2 bottles ginger ale and 2 bottles club soda.

Notes: Purchase Knudsen's Nectar at Whole Foods Market or other health food store. Do not substitute Knudsen's Nectar. Simple syrup is 2 parts sugar to 1 part water. Bring to a slow boil until clear - about 4 minutes. Cool before use. Refrigerate the nectar, ginger ale, and club soda. Put lemonade concentrate in the refrigerator overnight before use.
